**HEALTH RULES FOR SWINE**

**Certificate of Veterinary Inspection: 1.** All swine must be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection signed by an accredited veterinarian. The Certificate of Veterinary Inspection must be issued within the 30 days prior to the date of arrival at the show.

**Swine Identification Requirements:2.**

Breeding swine must be officially identified with one of the (a). following: A herd tattoo in combination with an ear notch; a state issued metal eartag; or an ISO-compliant 15-digit tag (including RFID).

Market Swine must be identified by an RFID (tag) registered (b). with Big Knob for official identification purposes at the Pennsylvania Farm Show.

**Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship Form: 3.** All animals must be accompanied by a Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship form. Pennsylvania law requires that a Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship exists, and that it be verified in writing for each exhibitor. This requirement is in addition to a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection requirement. To meet this requirement, a signed verification from the animal owner or caretaker, using the enclosed "Animal Owner or Caretaker's Verification of Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship" form must be completed by each exhibitor.

**Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship Forms will be collected at registration by Big Knob Staff members.** Each animal to be exhibited must be listed on the Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship form, OR be listed on an extra copy of the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection attached to the Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship form.

**Brucellosis and Pseudorabies Testing Requirements for Breeding 4. Swine:**

**Brucellosis: (a).**

All breeding swine for \* **exhibition and sale** must have had a negative brucellosis test **within the 30 days prior to the date of sale**, or must originate from a Validated Brucellosis Free Swine Herd, and the herd number, test results, and date of the last herd test shall be listed on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection.

**Pseudorabies: (b).**

All breeding swine for \* **exhibition and sale** must have had a negative pseudorabies test **within the 30 days prior to the date of sale**, or must originate from a Qualified Pseudorabies Negative Swine Herd, and the herd number, test results, and date of the last herd test shall be listed on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection. **Brucellosis and Pseudorabies Testing Requirements for \* Market Swine:**

**Brucellosis:(c).** No brucellosis test is required for market swine sold for immediate slaughter.

**Pseudorabies: (d).** No pseudorabies test is required for market swine sold for immediate slaughter
