HEALTH RULES FOR GOATS

Certificate of Veterinary Inspection: 1. All goats to be exhibited must be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection signed by an accredited veterinarian. The Certificate of Veterinary Inspection must be issued within the 30 days prior to the date of arrival at the show.

Goat Identification Requirements: 2.

All goats for exhibition must be identified by an official USDA **(a)**. scrapie eartag; a USDA-approved scrapie tattoo (in addition to individual ID); a USDA-approved custom scrapie eartag; an ISO-compliant 15-digit eartag (including RFID); or a breed registration tattoo if the tattoo is legible and the registration certificate accompanies the animal. The animal ID must be included on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection.

Market goats must be identified by an RFID (tag) registered with **(b)**. Big Knob **AND** one of the following: An official USDA scrapie eartag; a USDA-approved scrapie tattoo (in addition to individual ID); a USDA-approved custom scrapie eartag; an ISO-compliant 15-digit eartag (including RFID); or a breed registration tattoo if the tattoo is legible and the registration certificate accompanies the animal for official identification purposes at the Pennsylvania Farm Show.

Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship Form: 3. All animals must be accompanied by a Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship form. Pennsylvania law requires that a Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship exists, and that it be verified in writing for each exhibitor. This requirement is in addition to a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection requirement. To meet this requirement, a signed verification from the animal owner or caretaker, using the enclosed "Animal Owner or Caretaker's Verification of Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship" form must be completed by each exhibitor.

Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship forms will be collected at registration by Big Knob Staff members. Each animal to be exhibited must be listed on the Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship form, OR be listed on an extra copy of the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection attached to the Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship Form.
