Exhibitors will follow rules and entry times as listed under Agricultural and Home Economics Exhibits.

1. Grain should be bright, clean of chaff, weed seeds and broken kernels and straw.
2. One-gallon glass jars with lids or one-gallon plastic zip-lock bags are to be used to show grain in classes 11 through 17. If the fair management believes any of the exhibits were shown in previous years, those entries may be refused.
