SECTION 1 — BEES, HONEY AND WAX

RULES: Refer to Agricultural and Home Economics Committee

1. Comb honey is to be judged on perfection in filling, appearance, uniformity of capping, neatness and cleanliness.
2. Extracted honey is to be judged on moisture, freedom from foam and crystals, cleanliness, fill and flavor.
3. A cobana round or cut comb may also be exhibited as a "section".
