RULES: MACHINERY MUST BE PRE-1940 UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED

1. All equipment must be in operating condition and must be labeled as to what year it was manufactured.
2. Entries may only be operated at the discretion of the management.
3. Limited exhibit space has been provided — space will be given on the first-come, first-serve basis. Pre-registration is required using the application form in this tabloid.
4. Entries receiving prize money the previous year will only be eligible to win a ribbon the next year for that class.
5. Due to space available, ONLY ONE EXHIBIT PER PERSON is allowed in Dept. 24.
6. Small items will be accepted for display only as space permits in the basement exhibit area.
7. EXHIBITOR MUST BE AVAILABLE DURING JUDGING or have a designated person who is familiar with the equipment there.
8. JUDGING CRITERIA WILL BE AT THE DISCRETION OF THE JUDGE.
