HEALTH RULES FOR EQUINE ANIMALS

Certificate of Veterinary Inspection: 1. All equine animals must be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection signed by an accredited veterinarian. The Certificate of Veterinary Inspection must be issued within the 30 days prior to the date of arrival at the show. The name of the laboratory conducting the equine infectious anemia test, and the date of the test and result must be listed on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection.

Equine Infectious Anemia Test Requirements: 2. All equine animals must have tested negative for equine infectious anemia by an official test (Coggins or ELISA) within the 12 months prior of arrival at the show. Foals less than 6 months of age accompanied by a dam which meets the above requirements are exempt from equine infectious anemia testing requirements. If the foal is not accompanied by the dam, a copy of the dam's test results must accompany the foal to its final destination. The negative report must accompany the equine and must include an accurate description including age, color, sex and any other reliable identification such as tattoos, distinctive marks, etc. Solid color animals must be identified by some method of unique identification such as lip tattoo, brand, or at least two distinctive markings such as whirls. The name of the laboratory conducting the equine infectious anemia test, the date of the test and the negative test result must be listed on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection.

Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship Form: 3. All animals must be accompanied by a Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship form. Pennsylvania law requires that a Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship exists, and that it be verified in writing for each exhibitor. This requirement is in addition to a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection requirement. To meet this requirement, a signed verification from the animal owner or caretaker, using the enclosed "Animal Owner or Caretaker's Verification of Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship" form must be completed by each exhibitor.

Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship forms will be collected at registration by Big Knob Staff members. Each animal to be exhibited must be listed on the Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship form, OR be listed on an extra copy of the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection attached to the Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship form.

Rabies Vaccination: 4. A current rabies vaccination administered by a licensed veterinarian is required for animals three months of age and older. All vaccine label directions must be followed, and all rabies vaccinated equine animals must be accompanied by a rabies vaccination certificate or the vaccination information must be included on the Pennsylvania State Farm Show • Premium List • January 8-15, 2011 Certificate of Veterinary Inspection. If a rabies vaccination certificate is provided, the certificate must contain legible name and contact information of the veterinarian who administered the vaccine and the veterinarian's signature. A copy of the rabies vaccination certificate is acceptable.

Other Vaccination Recommendations: 5. The Department recommends that exhibitors consult with their veterinarians about the proper vaccination regimen for their animals.
